The number of employment by foreign-invested companies has enlarged every year by 10% from 2006 to 2008. In 2009, foreign-invested companies provided 8% of all workers in the country. This shows that despite the economic uncertainty, employment opportunities exist and are expected to grow as the world is rapidly globalizing.
